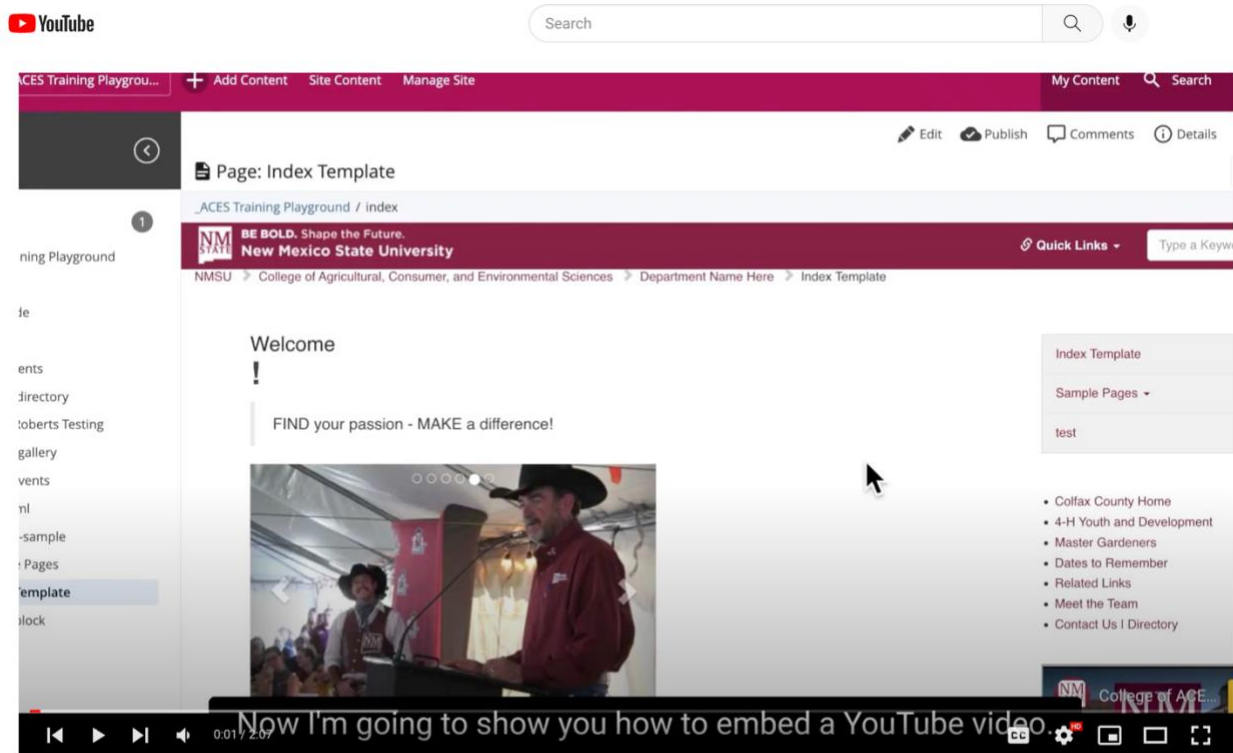


How to Embed a YouTube Video

1. Find the YouTube video you'd like to embed to your website. Please make sure that this video is compliant with ADA standards and offers subtitles so that it is accessible to everyone.

2. Right below the video, you'll see a "Share" button. Click on that button.

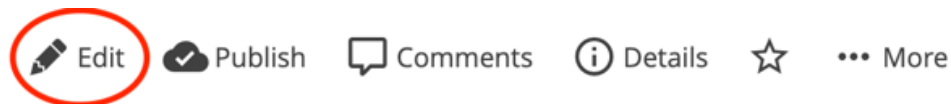
3. A pop-up window should appear. From this screen, click on where it says, “Embed.”



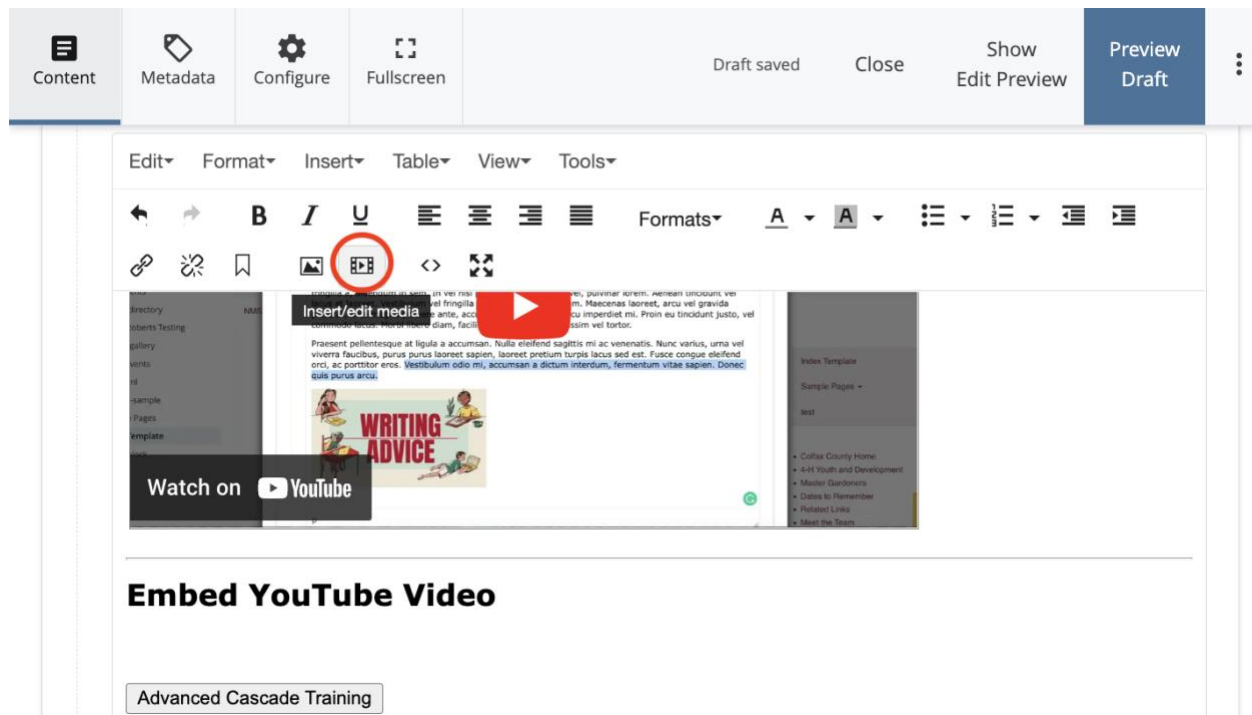
4. Once you click on “Embed,” HTML code will be given to you.
 - a. Before you copy this code, make sure to change the “Title” of the code to be descriptive of the video you are embedding. This is to ensure the video is ADA compliant.
 - b. Once this is done, you may copy the code, and go to your Cascade CMS site.



5. Make sure to click the “Edit” button at the top of your webpage to bring up the WYSIWYG editor.



6. Go to the section where you’d like to add the video and place your cursor.
 - a. Now, you will click on the Media button on the WYSIWYG editor tool bar.

7. On the pop-up screen, click on the second tab where it says “Embed”
 - a. Here is where you will paste the code you received from YouTube.
 - b. Once you are done, click “Ok”

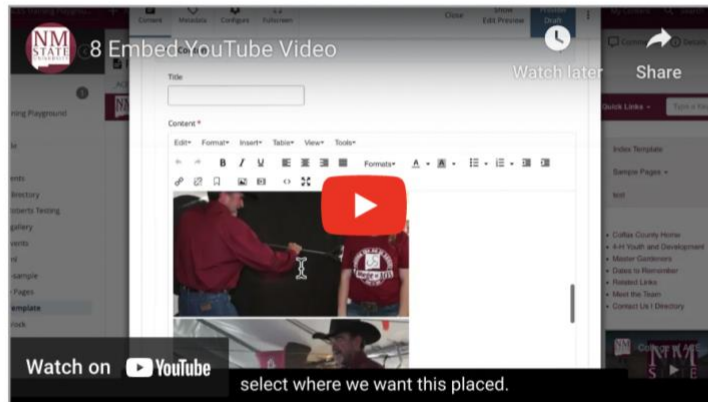
